PRE-SCHOOL

For those wishing to participate in an NCAS Instructor Pre-School, you should be aware of the following:

- Ask your Club Secretary to purchase the relevant NCAS Workbooks (Preliminary or Level 1 depending on your current accreditation).
- Ensure you have the relevant NCAS workbooks with you and bring these to the Pre-School.
- Wear Club Muster Uniform.
- No horses required.
- Bring sunscreen and a hat with you for instruction activities if time permits.

REFRESHER

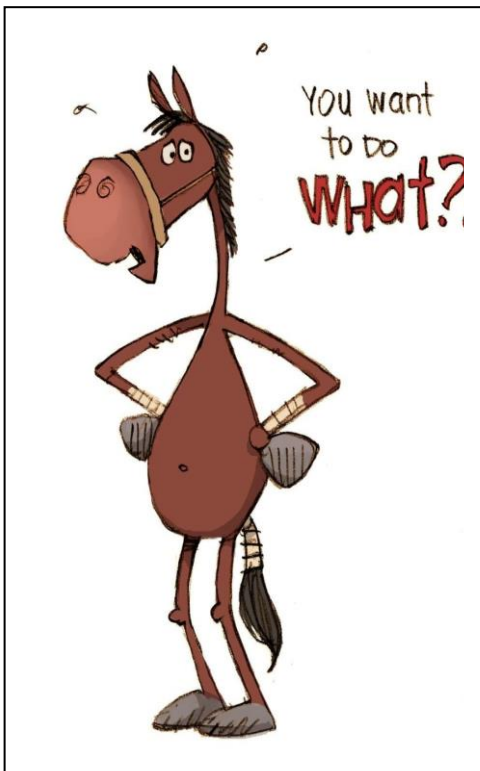
For those members that need to obtain a Refresher for PCAQ accreditation or NCAS accreditation, please note that you will require the following:

- Wear Club Muster Uniform.
- No horses required.
- Bring sunscreen and a hat with you for instruction activities if time permits.

LEVEL C PCAQ INSTRUCTOR ASSESSMENT

*For those undertaking their Level C Assessment on this day, please note that the following must be completed before the assessment can go ahead:

- Workbooks to be fully completed and each section signed off by a Club Instructor. [Ensure you have the workbooks with you on the day].
- Completion of your Working with Children and Young Adults (Blue Card) Application. [Blue Card details to be submitted with application to PCAQ].
- Payment/Completion of PCAQ form for assessment purposes. (You will need your blue card to complete this form).
- Formal Uniform for Candidates is essential so please ensure you have all the necessary clothing.
- Equipment to use for Lunging your horse and gear for a ridden assessment.
- A horse suitable for lunging, general riding and completing a small jumping course.
- A horsemanship topic will be provided to you from PCAQ upon receipt of your registration of your Assessment. The lecture needs to be in a suitable format for you to present to the riders at the Club on the day.
- Instruction to be undertaken for Candidates could include Troop Drill, Flatwork, Sporting Events and Jumping.
- Completion of an Open Book Exam.



GENERAL INFORMATION

- Redcliffe Club grounds are located at McGahey Street, Rothwell. Please note that the roundabout at Rothwell is still closed so you will need to turn into Coman Street South which leads into McGahey Street. Clubhouse is located in the corner and highly visible from the road.
- Registration commences at 0745am for an 0800am start! Finish around 2pm.
