- Venue:** Burpengary Pony Club, Rowley Road, Burpengary. To be run in conjunction with BEC EA ODE. Course open for walking from 3.30 p.m. Saturday.
- Helpers:** Zone riders get to do the same courses as EA riders, with benefits of Doctor, Vet & ambulance etc. on course at a much reduced entry fee but on the condition that they provide a helper. **It is a condition of entry that each Family with a rider entered, including Seniors, provides a non-riding HELPER during the competition.**
- Starting Time:** **Saturday 3rd June**, Dressage Time advised on Draw, Z26 Riders will ride after the EA riders. **Pony Club formal uniform required for Dressage phase**
8 am. Sunday 4th June, Cross country (Official classes start) & Showjumping
- Nominations:** **\$50.00 per Horse or \$35.00 if also competing in the EA Event on same horse.**
Zone 26 Riders Only.
- Awards:** **RUG** to winner of each **Official** class with 3 or more riders. **Trophy to 2nd place.**
SADDLECLOTH to winner of the Unofficial class with 3 or more riders. Trophy to 2nd place.
Ribbons to 6th.

- Rules:** **All riders must wear BODY PROTECTOR & MEDICAL ARMBAND on Cross Country phase.** Run under P.C.A.Q. rules, open to PCAQ members of Zone 26 only. As a condition of entry, each family must provide a helper on the day of competition, jobs will be allocated, but your preference may be indicated on the Nomination Form. Options could include Gear Check, Marshall, Timekeeper, Start or Finish for Cross country, Penciller, Canteen. The course is closed to all riders from 12 midnight, 7/5/17. Competitors must be present in Full uniform to collect ribbons and trophies. **Camping/Stables/Yards not available to Zone 26 riders/horses. Riders may compete in both this event and the EA event on the same horse, if it is the same height class. In that case riders will ride 2 dressage tests, their EA and Pony Club test, but will only do one round of showjumping and cross country.**
