## ***Please Note***

- Performance cards are required for all official classes and must be handed in prior to the commencement of the event; riders without a card must compete HC.
- Riders may enter one competitive horse in Official Programme and one competitive horse in the Unofficial Classes or two horses in the same section, one of which must be ridden HC. If in the same class, the HC horse must be ridden second. The horse to be ridden HC must be nominated as such on the entry form. (In the case that numbers need to be capped – 2nd horse nominations may not be accepted).
- Riders currently competing in a graded class cannot ride a graded horse in an unofficial section BUT you may ride a graded horse in an unofficial class if you are not currently competing in official classes.
- This event will be run in accordance with PCAQ rules, Dressage Tests are taken from the PCAQ Dressage Test Book Apr 2014.
- DISCLAIMER: Neither the organising committee of any contest to which these rules apply, nor PCAQ, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- The organising committee reserves the right to: cancel any class or event, combine classes if less than 3 competitors, or divide classes according to the numbers nominated and the rules governing splitting of groups, alter advertised times, transfer competitors between sections of a class, and to refuse any entry with or without stating a reason.
- PCAQ standard footwear and head protection must be worn. Helmets must comply with PCAQ rules. All riders must pass a gear check prior to the beginning of each test.
- Judges decision is final, any disputes must be lodged, in writing within 30 minutes after the event, and be accompanied by a \$50 fee.
- Riders must be in attendance in full pony club uniform for presentation or may forfeit their awards.
- Horse Health Declaration Forms are required by all competitors.
- All competitors must be a current financial riding member of PCAQ or PCA.
- Requests for refunds after the draw is published must be accompanied by a vet certificate or medical certificate and must be received within 1 week of the event. A 10% administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- Classes will be combined if there are less than 3 riders in a class.
