Zones will forward the teams to us on a spreadsheet. They will not collect your nomination payment. You will be responsible for your nomination and payment.

Nomination will be on nominate.

Please note that nominations close online on Friday March 15th. Zones will forward us who is in each team, team managers & helpers. Zones have until Wednesday March 20th to email teams list.

If Zones have riders keen to compete but cannot put together a team, we are more than happy to assist in putting together composite teams where possible.

CAMPING & STABLING

Caboolture PC Grounds – 199 Williams Rd, Moodlu 4510

- Camping fee \$20 per campsite per night (No Powered Sites)
- Yarding fee \$10 per horse per night (Campers have 1st rights)
- No Electric Fences. Portable Metal Yards maybe used under the direction of the grounds Co-ordinator or organising committee. Portable fencing MUST be secured. No yards in Camping area. The organising committee have the decision to not allow portable yards should it be deemed unsafe.

CANTEEN

• Canteen will be open Sunday from 7am for breakfast, lunch & snacks.

Horse Health Declaration and Rider Waiver forms must be filled out and handed in to your Zone Team Manager. Your Team Manager will then collect and hand out your Rider Number.

BIOSECURITY

In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/horses. Including and not limited to feeding, watering and vet cost for the time of the restrictions.

TEAM AGE GROUPS

Teams may comprise of 3 or 4 riders. The 3 best times each team will count.

- 12 years and under
- 13 years and under 17 years
- 17 years and over

SCORING

- 1st 10 points
- 2nd 9 points
- 3rd 8 points
- 4th 7 points
- 5th 6 points

- 6th 5 points
- 7th 4 points
- 8th
 3 points
- 9th
 2 points
 - 2 points
- 10th 1 point

ZONE TEAM MANAGERS

- Each zone should appoint an overall Team Manager who is responsible for all members of his/her zone at all times.
- In addition, Zones should appoint a Team Manager for each age group that the zone is competing in, who will be responsible for his/her teams at all times.
- Only the Zone Team Managers shall be allowed in the competition area.
- Overall Zone Team Managers are to advise before the start of competition if there are any substitutions of riders or horses in their teams.
- Any approach to organisers for any reason whatsoever must be made through a Team Manager.
- Protests must be lodged through Overall Team Manager within 30 minutes of the results being displayed. Fee of \$100 only refundable if the protest is upheld.
- Overall Team Manager from each Zone is responsible for collecting all Horse Health Declaration, Rider Waiver Forms & distributing rider numbers.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT

The Organisers reserve the right:

- (a) to cancel any class or event
- (b) to divide any class
- (c) to alter the advertised times
- (d) to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason
- (e) to transfer competitors between sections of a class
- (f) to combine classes if less than 3 competitors

CONDITIONS

- All events will be run in accordance with PCQ Sporting Rules 2023 & Gear Rules as per 1st Jan 2024 PCA National Gear rule book.
- Horses must be correctly saddled, and competitors must wear approved helmets and riding boots at **ALL** times.
- Competitors may exercise their horse in the area provided. Horses may be schooled or exercised only by their nominated rider on the day of the competition. Riders disregarding this rule may incur disqualification from the event.
- Teams will compete as a unit, entering and leaving the competition area together. Sporting events will be judged individually with each rider acknowledging the judge when it is his/her turn to compete.
- Teams should be formed from one (1) Zone from each State. Composite Zone Teams can be coordinated if Zones have riders but cannot put a team together. Every effort will be made to find a place in a composite team for every rider.
- In the event of equality, the winning team will be the one with the most wins, if still equal, the most seconds ect.
- Mounted Presentation Competitors must be present to receive awards.
- Permission is required from the Technical Delegate or Judge in Chief to leave before presentation.
- Events to be electronically timed, where possible.
- Teams will compete as per published draw.
- Protests must be lodged through Overall Team Manager within 30 minutes of the results being displayed plus \$100 protest fee.
- Horses must be ridden at a walk at all times when not competing. This includes the car park areas.
- First Aid in attendance
- No smoking on Caboolture Pony Club Grounds.
- PCQ Alcohol Policy applies at this event.
- No rider is to have their mobile phone on them while mounted. If you are seen with your mobile phone on you while mounted, you will be eliminated for the day.
